



The Rock In The Sun Background Wardrobe - Haitian citizen

ALL Background Talent representing Haitian citizens are asked to bring enough clothing to create 5-6 clothing changes (mix & match). **ALL clothing will be exposed to dirt, debris and possible movie blood that is machine-washable. However, do NOT bring ANY clothing that can't get distressed. A wardrobe rep will be on set to select your clothing changes.**

Please use the above reference photos to gain a better idea of the varied imagery we are looking to capture; Google Haiti earthquake for more images.

BG should bring their changes inside an old bag, duffle, backpack or trash bag that can possibly be used on-camera; like they are living out of what they can carry.

- Clothing is for hot weather - Summertime
- **Color palette** - Caribbean colors; yellow, blue, green, turquoise, purple, pink, rose, navy, brown, gray - no solid red shirts or too much black or white
- Choose clothes in mostly solid colors; some stripes and patterns are okay (see photos)
- NO commercial logos on clothes (generic logos or logos that are faded are okay)
- (Old) Shoes: flip flops, sandals, sneakers, boots
- **Women and Girls:** Distressed/worn/old/discarded dresses, sundresses, jumpers, tank tops, t-shirts, head scarves/wraps, cotton hats, hair ribbons for girls
- **Men and Boys:** Distressed/worn/old/discarded t-shirts, cotton pants, jeans, shorts, warm-up pants, old short-sleeve (SS) dress shirts

Note for Haitian Children and Staff in Orphanage: Girls & Women should try to bring more sundresses and skirts vs. shorts options. Men & Boys should try to bring more SS dress shirts that button down the front vs plain t-shirts. Parents who will let their small children wear simply a t-shirt and diaper are welcomed. It is a powerful image.
